



Gifted Education Seminar Summer Sessions

LEARN HOW TO MEET THE NEEDS OF *ALL* STUDENTS IN YOUR CLASSROOM

The Illinois State Board of Education invites ALL teachers and administrators to deepen their understanding of how to teach and reach gifted and talented students in their own classroom. The training consists of the following modules: Overview and Perspectives, Knowing the Gifted, Differentiation, and Gifted Models for the classroom. This training is a combination of face-to-face participation and independent work using a USB drive which will be provided to each participant. Note: Private and parochial school teachers who hold a teaching certificate are eligible to enroll in the Gifted Education Seminar.
