A qualified voter is someone who is a US citizen, 18 years of age, a resident of the District for at least 30 days prior to the vote, and not disqualified by any reason set forth in NYS Election Law §5-106.

Qualified voters on the most recent years' poll lists will be automatically sent an absentee ballot. Anyone who meets the definition of a "qualified voter," but does not believe he/she will be on the School District's poll list, which contains the names of residents who voted in the last four years' elections, please contact the District Clerk, Ms. Cindy Homer, by email at chomer@johnsburgcsd.org as soon as possible to ensure timely receipt of an absentee ballot for the 2020 annual meeting/election.
